21 THIS MATTER came before the Court on Petitioners' Second Corrected Motion for a
22 Preliminary Injunction. Having considered Petitioners' motion, WDFW's response thereto,
23 Petitioners' reply, having considered all declarations and attachments thereto in support of the
24 aforementioned briefs, and having considered the arguments of counsel, the court finds and
25 concludes that Petitioners have failed to meet their burden of establishing entitlement to a
26 preliminary injunction, on the following grounds:

Petitioners have not established a clear legal or equitable right, as they have not
established a likelihood of prevailing on the merits;
